

SPEED CAMERA PROGRAM

VILLAGE OFFICIALS ARE CONSIDERING A PROPOSAL TO INSTALL FOUR FIXED POSITION SPEED CAMERAS IN THE VILLAGE AND TO DEPLOY ONE HAND HELD SPEED CAMERA WITH OFFICERS. TO ANSWER SOME OF YOUR QUESTIONS THE FOLLOWING FACT SHEET WAS MADE:

Q: I thought Governor Mike DeWine just outlawed cameras, is this legal?

A: Yes, the ban that was passed is for county and township roads. City and villages have home rule.

Q: Why do we need traffic cameras?

A: The village conducted a speed study in 2023. There were five locations in which speed of traffic was tracked. The study found there was rampant speeding (Greater than 10 MPH over limit) throughout the village. Details of the studies will follow but on average, the village had approximately 1500 speeders daily.

Q: Why not just hire more officers?

A: The village has struggled to find officers given the current pay scale. This is a national issue and not isolated to the village of East Canton. Further, it takes an officer on average 30 minutes to conduct a traffic stop, write a citation, and then do the required paperwork at the PD. Its physically impossible for an officer to handle the amount of speeding violations that we are encountering. A full time officer will cost approximately \$75k annually when considering wages and benefits.

Q: Do officers have to "man" the cameras?

A: No, that is not a requirement for fixed position cameras but we will also have a mobile camera which will be operated by officers.

Q: At what speed over the limit will citations be issued?

A: Citations will be issued for all speed violations at 10MPH or over the limit.

Q: Why should we send 40% of the citation money to the camera company?

A: Targeting and Solutions, Ltd. Would be responsible for the administration work required for the system and all annual calibration done on the equipment.

Q: What upfront costs are incurred by the village?

A: There are no upfront costs incurred.

Q: How does the village plan to ensure residents are adequately notified?

A: Once passed, a postcard will be sent to all residents formally notifying them of the addition of the cameras.

Q: How does the village plan to ensure that motorists are adequately notified?

A: For the first 30 days, all violators will be given a warning and not a citation. Signage would be placed at village limits

Q: What does the village plan on using revenue generated for?

A: The goal of this project is not to generate revenue but rather to improve safety of our residents. With that being said, if revenue generated is significant, the village will use it to fund the police department. This program could potentially fulfill the the financing needs for the PD without future police levies.

O: What will officers do if the cameras are installed?

A: The cameras would be placed in high traffic areas. Officers would increase their presence on the side streets of the village to enforce traffic laws for violations such as speeding and failure to stop at stop signs. In addition, officers would increase presence at local businesses to dissuade what seems to be an uptick in petty theft.


