It is my responsibility to carry out the duties, obligations and responsibilities of the office of Mayor as set forth in the Ohio Revised Code. My focus and that of your elected Village Council, will be to continue to provide excellent service to our village citizens for the betterment and safety of the Village of East Canton.

The Police Department is asking the village residents be aware of things out of the ordinary, be aware when you are driving around the village, if you see or hear something thing that just does not seem right, please report it, by calling East Canton dispatch at 330-488-9435. You do not have to give your name.

In 2021 the Village's Street / Service Department was very busy. Village Administrator Ed Collins reported the following for the year: Water tests for lead and copper came back negative and were within EPA standards. Installed 100 new Radio read water meters Total meters installed in the program so far are 563 with 180 meters to still install., responded to 137 OUPS marking, for all local utility companies (OUPS is a call before you dig company), reported 19 street lights out in Village to AEP, repaired 6 catch basins, and responded to 111 village residents work orders. Additionally, they collected 1700 lbs. of debris from the kid catcher (at creeks) and swept up 1150 lbs. of dirt and debris from the downtown area and took 24 truckloads to C&D Land-fill.

Water Department crews responded to 4 water breaks, which resulted in water loss of 5000 gallons of water. This marked a huge drop from the 563,000 gallons of water lost the previous year. The village invested in a new pump for the pump house. The old pump was sent out to be rebuilt and is now on the shelf as a back up. The water department implemented a new all call listing in 2021. Forms were sent out requesting you information and how you would like to be contacted if there should be a water break in your area of the village. For those that wish to sign up, please do so at Village Hall. It is important that keep your phone number up to date . Should you change your phone number please contact the water department so we can keep the records up to date.

Water bills are mailed every 2 months.

2021 TAX NOW DUE April 15!

The Village of East Canton has a 1.5% income tax, established on Jan. 1, 2004. **Village taxes are due on April 15, 2022 Failure to file by April 15 will result in a \$25.00 monthly late filing fee (maximum \$150.00).**

The Village of East Canton has mandatory filing for all residents. This means anyone 16 years of age or older are required to file a tax return (if employed within the Village or outside the Village). If you are a senior citizen or disabled you only have to fill out a Village Tax form once stating you are retired or disabled and have no taxable income. Please notify the Village Tax Department if you move. Also required to file: All residents who conduct a business operation within the Village or outside the Village, including rental property. All non-resident businesses that perform operations within the Village must file a tax return.

EMERGENCY SIRENS – The Village of East Canton, in cooperation with other county & state agencies, has a siren system to alert citizens to weather emergencies. In the event a tornado warning is confirmed in Stark County or when weather conditions may jeopardize persons or property the warning siren will be activated as soon as possible. During extreme weather, always listen to the local TV or radio stations for up-to-the minute information. Our siren is located at the Osnauburg Township Fire Department. A test is run the first Monday of each month at 12 noon.

CONSTRUCTION—Any construction of fences, garages, house additions and storage sheds will require a permit. Demolition Permits are required also inside Village Limits.

PARK – East Canton's Village Park is an asset to area residents providing 3 ball fields with dugouts & bleachers that serve as the home fields to teams with over 500 East Canton & Osnaburg Twp. youngsters.

The park also has a ½ mile walking track, tennis courts, two pavilions, & modern playground equipment including a monster truck, train & Noah's Ark.

Use of park shelters on weekends & holidays are by **reservation only** and can be **rented** by calling 330-488-0220 option #6 or #7. Small Pavilion lower area of the park rents for \$50.00 a day for Village residents and \$75.00 for non residents will seat 48 people, the upper pavilion rents for \$50.00 a day for Village residents and \$75.00 for non residents and will seat 78 people. The pavilions do have electric outlets and charcoal units.

The park is open from April 1, through November 1, but may be used all year round weather permitting. No restroom facilities or water during winter months.

SIDEWALKS / STREETS — Property owners are responsible for maintaining sidewalks, keeping them clear of snow in winter and sweeping off debris year round.

The Village of East Canton does have an ordinance regarding residential snow parking ban. Village officials will post the parking ban noticed within the village when implement and we urge residents who park on village streets to remove their vehicles to allow the street crew to do a more effective job of snow removal. The Village assumes no responsibility for snow removal around your vehicle if it is park on the street and refusal to adhere to the parking ban will result in vehicles being towed at the owners expense.

FACTS: Use the Right S.A.L.T.

Stuff: Road salt (sodium chloride) only works above 15 degrees F.

Amount: Spreading more salt does not improve deicing.

Location: Salt only belongs on your sidewalk and driveway, never on lawn. One teaspoon of salt permanently pollutes 5 gallons of water.

Time: Salt works best when it is applied before the snow falls or right after snow is removed from your driveway or sidewalk. Never apply when rain is in the forecast.

GARAGE SALES – Garage Sales are permitted in the Village 3 times a year for 3 days each time. Permits are required and may be obtained at NO charge at Village Hall (Monday through Friday 9 a.m.—3:30 p.m.)

VILLAGE COMMUNITY GARAGE SALE - JUNE 10, 11,& 12, 2022. No Permit is required for the Community Sale.

PARK WALKING TRACK—Walkers and runners may use the 1/2 mile track year round for health, exercise and fun. **NO** bikes or skateboards are permitted on the track in the park.

DIRT BIKES / ATV'S - Per State Law, property owners are permitted to operate dirt bikes and ATV's on their personal property as long as the Village's noise ordinance isn't violated.

These vehicles may NOT be driven on Village streets unless they are licensed and insured. They can not be driven to a gas station to get gas unless licensed to be operated on the street. Warnings and / or tickets will be issued by The Village of East Canton Police Department for violation of the law.
