Application and Regulations



Location, Dates and Hours: Deadline for applications= May 15, 2023

1. East Canton Rotary Annual Community Festival will be held at the Foltz Community Center on 224 Wood Street N at the rear of building and along Browning Street.
2. **Friday, June 9th, 4-10 pm. and Saturday, June 10th, 2023 from 4-10 pm.**
3. Vendors must pull trailers in between 6:00 pm on Thursday, June 8, 2023. All vendors must be set-up and vehicles moved to the designated parking area by 3:30 p.m. each day.
4. The Vendor fees to participate are as follows:
 - a. **Vendors with trailers (including water and electric)- \$150**
 - b. **Local Non-Profit organizations space (no utilities)- \$25, with utilities= \$50**
 - c. **Business spaces (no utilities)- \$50**
5. All Vendors must pre-register by completing this application. All applicants will be notified of acceptance. Vendors' who have not completed the required application will be asked to leave
6. All Vendors must be prepared to stay until the Festival closes at 10:00 p.m. each night with the exception of inclement weather

Space

1. All Vendors will be notified their assigned space upon arriving on Wednesday, June 8th with Trailer or Tent. It is each vendor's responsibility to provide their own chairs, tent, canopy, or other display equipment. All tents or canopies must be secure by stakes or some type of tie downs/weights
2. Vendors must display a sign or business cards on table identifying their contact name or business address as well as signage for items they have for sale and the price of the item/game

General Guidelines:

1. Vendors are to set their own prices
2. No loud music or sound during the time the bands are playing
3. It is the vendor's responsibility to obtain all licenses and permits and pay any fees required by State or Local government. This includes the vendor's license for goods sold and any sales tax regulations
4. Vendors will keep their area clean and free of debris during the festival and will clean their area after the festival each night
5. All vendors may sell soda, lemonade or water. All fresh lemonade must be sold at the same price agreed upon by the participating vendors
5. No Live animals may be sold or given away at the festival except for gold fish
6. All Vendors should have their area cleaned and vacated by Sunday, June 11, 2023 at 11:00 am

Available Products or Activities:

The East Canton Rotary has the right to monitor the products that are for sale by vendors and restrict the sale of items that do not meet the mission of the festival. Items offered at the Festival may also be restricted to help maintain a diverse market for the customers as well as provide enough like items so the customers do not have a lengthy wait to receive the product

1. Local producers are welcome. Hand crafted products are welcome
2. Games for all ages encouraged. Dunking booth, fish pond, craft stations, all games
3. **NO ALCOHOLIC beverages** are permitted on the premises
4. **NO FLEA MARKET or second hand type items are permitted**

Compliance:

East Canton Rotary Annual Community Festival is not responsible for the enforcement of USDA, ODOA or any local regulations. Each vendor is responsible to be aware and in compliance with regulations

All vendors are independent entities and are responsible for compliance with local codes and paying all applicable taxes, federal, state and local. Personal and product liability is the responsibility of the vendor
